## EIOPA’s view on European implementation of IDD for insurance distributors (including banks)

**Speaker :** Mr David COWAN, Leader of the Conduct of Business Policy Team, EIOPA (European Insurance and Occupational Pension Authority). Mr COWAN will discuss the European implementation of the insurance Distribution Directive (“IDD”), the results of the country by country reporting analysis by EIOPA, the general good and the obstacles to Free Provision of Services.

**Moderator:** Mr Diego MANZETTI, General counsel of AIG Europe. Mr MANZETTI will open the Q&A session on practical issues of international IDD implementation and issues banks face as distributors of insurance products.
